Heifer was founded by Dan West in 1944 after he returned from volunteer service during the Spanish Civil War. During that experience he saw what long term solutions worked. Dan was a farmer in the Midwest of the United States and used his connections and knowledge to partner with farmers with different livestock and crops. This is how Heifer began. He enlisted ranchers and farmers as Seagoing Cowboys to ship the live sock, cattle, pigs, chickens, goats, etc., and crops from the United States to other countries

The Seagoing Cowboys were Ranchers and Farmers who volunteered to help Heifer by using their knowledge of Animal Husbandry and Agriculture. They would use their knowledge as they accompanied the animals across land, sea and air. As they did this their faith was tested and renewed by what they experienced and discovered. More then 7,000 men and women volunteered for Heifer and gained a unique experience they will never forget. Today Heifer primarily serves partnering families using local channels in the countries they serve.

Heifer has five focuses in the work they do: Economic Development, Women's Empowerment, Environmental Sustainability, Risk Mitigation and Food Security and Nutrition.
