

Our extra giving emphasis for September is the rental assistance provided by Newcomers Access Center for refugee families. Quoting from an email the church received from NAC, they said that housing is perhaps the biggest challenge faced by immigrant and refugee families, who give up everything to leave dangerous, warravaged countries and start a new life from scratch. Newcomers Access Center has an urgent request for help in providing rental support to help keep Newcomer families in their homes. We in Pomona Fellowship can help by including a check for this purpose in our offering. Mark that the check is for NAC rent. Or we can mail a check directly to Newcomers Access Center at 233 W.
